This three semester on-line program for graduates consists of 8 coursework units and a project. Included is a unit of Blood Transfusion Service Medicine and one on Hospital Transfusion Medicine. These units have been developed with considerable input from leading scientists in the field.

The course also offers students the opportunity to take elective units in areas such as business, computing and other areas of science.

The program adds to the School's professionally-orientated graduate coursework programs which include a Master of Infectious Disease, a Master of Infection Control, a Master of Clinical Cytogenetics as well as, the generic Master of Biomedical Sciences. Graduate Certificates and Postgraduate Diplomas are also available, as well as a Graduate Certificate in Bioinformatics.
