The Australian and New Zealand Society of Blood Transfusion is offering a grant of up to AUD\$2,000 to assist a person from a resource poor country in the East Asia or the Pacific Island nations to attend the HSANZ/ANZSBT/ASTH Annual Scientific Meeting.

This meeting will be held in Sydney, Australia, from the
30 October – 2 November 2011

It represents an ideal opportunity to learn of recent developments in apheresis, haematology and blood transfusion.

The award is open to any person who is actively working in any area of blood transfusion (medical, scientific, nursing, administration) who resides in a resource poor country in the East Asia or the Pacific Island nations. The AUD\$2,000 must be used towards the cost of airfares and accommodation.

Free registration to the Congress will be provided.

The successful applicant is also encouraged to spend some time receiving continuing education and training at an Australian blood transfusion centre or hospital blood bank. Assistance may be provided in placement in such an establishment, but the award winner must meet all additional accommodation and transport costs.

Applications (no form available) should include details of qualifications; current and past employment; area of special interest, preferred location of additional training and any other sources of funds available.
