



## **OVERSEAS TRAVEL GRANT 2010**

It is with great pleasure that we announce details of an overseas travel grant for ANZSBT members, funded by CSL Bioplasma, for a maximum of \$5000. Suitable purposes for funding would include visits to overseas laboratories to learn new techniques or gain experience and attendance at overseas scientific meetings or courses. The award is to be taken up within 12 months of the closing date of the application.

Applications should be received by the Secretariat no later than Monday, 2<sup>nd</sup> August, 2010 and should include a letter of application outlining the reasons for the application: the purposes to which the grant (if successful) would be used; anticipated costs and any other possible sources of funding; and a letter of recommendation from your Head of Department supporting your application.

If for the purpose of attending a scientific meeting it would be expected that the applicant would have submitted an abstract, then evidence of the abstract should be submitted with the application.

Council has resolved that awarding of grants is to be based on scientific or educational merit of the application as well as the availability of other funding for this purpose. Our aim is to ensure that Society members who do not normally have access to significant funds for overseas travel can receive help from the CSL Bioplasma Travel Grant.

We are indebted to CSL Bioplasma for the funding of this grant.
